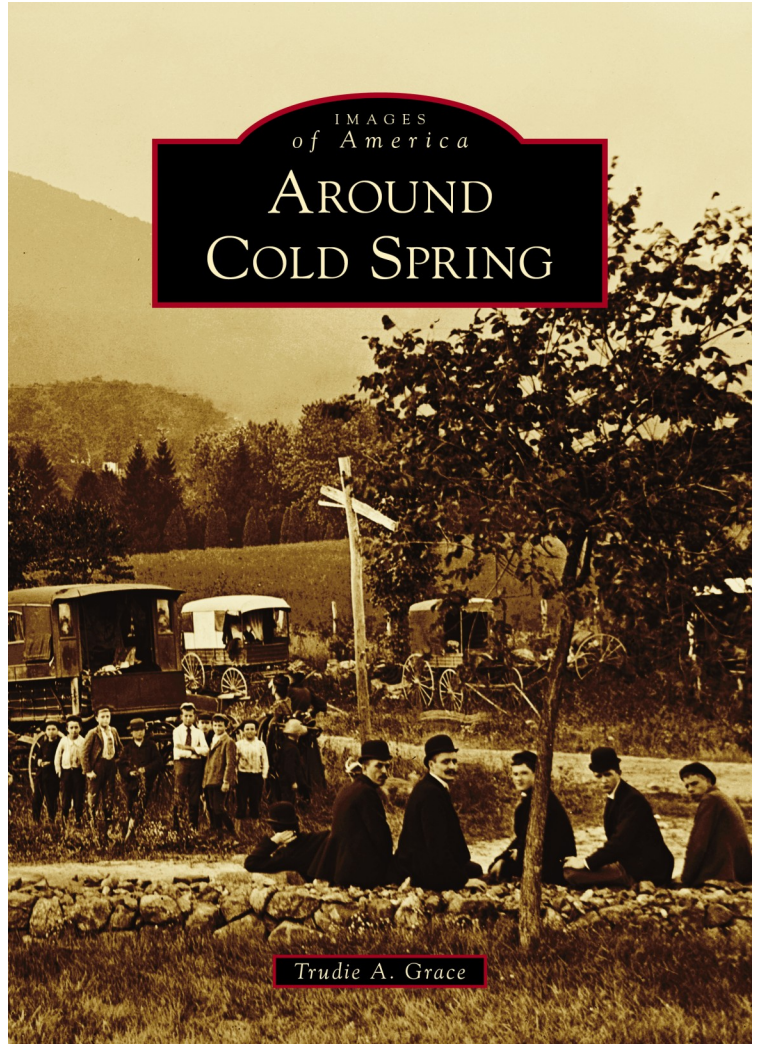


AROUND COLD SPRING Trudie A. Grace

The historic village of Cold Spring, New York, lies on the east bank of the Hudson River in the heart of the scenic Hudson Highlands, about 50 miles north of New York City. *Around Cold Spring* features images of the village of Cold Spring, the neighboring hamlet of Garrison, the village of Nelsonville, and other parts of the Town of Philipstown. The book highlights the historical significance of the area in the 19th and early 20th centuries. The original research and rare, vintage photographs make this book a valuable and unique historical resource.

More than half of the 223 photographs are from the PCHS, and the remainder are from 19 private collections. The photographs are accompanied by factually rich captions and depict a bygone era through views of Hudson River activities, local businesses, civic associations and celebrations, rural scenes and activities, and architecturally significant buildings, such as mansions, schools, and churches. The author, Dr. Trudie A. Grace, curator of the PCHS, has also included an introductory essay of 2,600 words and a bibliography. *Around Cold Spring* is the only comprehensive history of Philipstown available.
